**“Education for Expats”:** The Netherlands is committed to choice in Dutch education and expats find a huge range of schools and universities in the Netherlands to consider when enrolling their child into the Dutch education system, including numerous international schools of which some are also subsidised. During the Expat Fair Eindhoven expats can meet several schools and universities follow presentations to help them to understand the Netherlands education system. So they can make their choice from the multitude of schools to enrol their child into the Netherlands school system.
